Leasing Club.

The Contest is in three parts; a written test, team questions, and individual buzzer questions. contest covers the biology of dairy animal care, nutrition, dairy products, commercial history, operations, safety, The regulations. Anne contestants, including those unable to attend the competition, worked every Sunday from January to April to get ready for this year's contest.

Our Junior representative was Vivienne Nevitt and she joined two other juniors from Carroll County to form a combined team. The team

placed third overall in the state.

Our Intermediates were Abby Bearden, Iris Lily, and Michael Merriam. As a team they placed fifth in the state


Bullride Mania returns to once again entertain the residents of Anne Arundel


