MOTIONS


At the May 9, 2023 meeting of the Board of Directors, a motion was approved to purchase a Lap Top Quickbooks online. Cost not to exceed \$2500.

It was a great evening seeing all the kids bring their animal projects to the Fairgrounds to be weighed and tagged to identify their project for the 2023 Fair.

We had some retired 4-H and FFA members return to help the kids put the tags in their animals' ears and offer assistance to anyone who needed it. Previously in January, we had 4 steers

weighed in.

We are looking forward to a great turnout of animals in the Barn Area at this year's Fair. New to the Livestock Auction this year, will be more Turkeys and the addition of the champion and reserve champion pen of market rabbits.
